In the Gospels

Blessed are the **peacemakers**, for they will be called sons of God.

Matthew 5:9

Salt is good, but if it loses its saltiness, how can you make it salty again? Have salt in yourselves, and be at **peace** with each other.

Mark 9:50

Peace I leave with you; my **peace** I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.

His purpose was to create in himself one new man out of the two, thus making **peace**, ¹⁶ and in this one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross, by which he put to death their hostility. ¹⁷ He came and preached **peace** to you who were far away and peace to those who were near.
