



Why the Church?

- First and foremost marketplace ministers are disciples who make disciples, and gather with other believers in local churches/fellowships.
- In every context the Holy Spirit has been working through local believers before cross-cultural workers arrive, and the local church will remain long after these workers leave.
- Preventable attrition of cross cultural workers all comes back to spiritual formation, and that is developed in local church families

A Common Problem – Current Reality

- Faith-driven church-based leaders (clergy) struggle to bless & support Christian business people in • their fellowships
- Faith-driven marketplace leaders (laity) want to be connected to discipleship and missional efforts • more than occasional prayer and financial support.

A Proposed Solution – Envisioned Future

- Church-based leaders IDENTIFY faith-driven professionals and entrepreneurs who deeply want to • change the current reality
- Marketplace leaders and church-based leaders EMPOWER that group with access to formatted/ • curated resources (i.e content, connections and capital) and ADAPT language that is shared by both types of leaders to take the Gospel into marketplaces where lesus is needed most.
